KÜLTÜR GEMMA!

kültür gemma! is a project to foster the artistic work of migrants and BIPOC. We annually award free work scholarships and fellowships to Viennese cultural institutions. In addition to the financial and non-material support of individual projects, kültür gemma! sees itself as a cultural networking platform.

Our goal is to establish migrant positions as a matter of course in the predominantly white cultural scene and to do justice to the plurality of the city in cultural life as well.

MAK – MUSEUM OF APPLIED ARTS

The MAK - Museum of Applied Arts was founded over 150 years ago as the Museum of Decorative Arts together with the University of Applied Arts. Its aim has always been not only to preserve and research particularly valuable objects, but also to educate and train its public in crafts and aesthetics.

Today, the museum's collection no longer only includes applied art and design, but also sees architecture and contemporary art as its core competencies. The MAK's objectives have also expanded: In the halls of its permanent collection, in its special exhibitions and in its discursive program, the MAK seeks to examine the role of design, art and architecture in our society and in relation to the challenges of the 21st century.

This also includes taking the museum's democratic mission seriously and making its offerings accessible to all people, regardless of their cultural or socio-economic background.

FELLOWSHIP

Together with **kültür gemma!** the MAK is offering a fellowship in our Department of Art Education and Outreach. The fellowship is for 6 months and is endowed with 1300€ per month. The aim of the fellowship is to realize your own education project within the museum program.

Typical educational concepts include guided tours, workshops, evening programs such as talks or lectures.

However, the MAK also welcomes completely new formats! It can relate to the MAK collection, its permanent showrooms or the current exhibitions.

The concept is developed in cooperation with the MAK art educators. In addition to realizing the project, the Fellow will work in the day-to-day operations of the education department and thus get to know the work of art educators.

Are you interested in art and history? In culture and in the shaping of everyday life? Or are you interested in social processes?

Have you ever carried out a project, an artistic project, as part of a social commitment or participated in the organization of a major event?

Would you like to work in a big museum?

Are you good at communicating with a wide variety of people?

+ a letter of motivation

DEADLINE

The application deadline is May 10, 2024.

Start of the fellowship is June 1, 2024.

The decision on the fellowship will be made jointly by a jury consisting of representatives of
kültür gemma! and MAK.

All applicants will receive feedback by May 17.

The selection interviews will take place the following week.
