**Stromkilometer is both a prize and a challenge** that is awarded to students, alumni and employees of the University of Applied Arts Vienna.

The school ship Bertha von Suttner has so far rewarded high school graduates with a multiple (highschool graduation present) of artists.

Students, alumni and employees of the Angewandte are invited to design a multiple as a gift for the 2025/2026 graduates of the Schulschiff.

The gift should be a sign of remembrance of the school ship and the graduation.

The design is to be realized in a limited edition only for the number of approx. 100 high school graduates.

When submitting your design, please note that the **sum of €700** must cover the entire costs of implementation in the required print run.

As the work will be presented as a gift, **please also consider the form for this.**

**1.400€ is available as prize money** (700€ for the best submission and 700€ for implementation).

**Jury criteria:**  
originality, aesthetics, CI of the school ship, reference to the Matura, reference to the school ship.

**DEADLINE for submissions: Sunday, 10.05.2026.**

**The jury meeting will take place on Wednesday, 13.05.2026 from 14:00 to 16:00 at the University of Applied Arts Vienna.** Applicants must be present to pitch their ideas to the jury. On this day, the participants will be asked to present their idea to the jury themselves and in person in a short presentation (+ possibly with a prototype).  
The results will be announced afterwards.

**The multiples must then be completed by June 15th, 2026 and handed over to the management of the school ship.**

**On approx. June 17th, 2026,** the objects should be handed over to the students in person during the **Matura ceremony.** A description (incl. image) of the project must be submitted as a .doc and .pdf for the school and Angewandte homepage.
